

# REVEG BONDED FIBRE MATRIX (BFM)

## WHAT IS IT?

**BONDED FIBRE MATRICES (BFM'S)** are spray-on mats of varying strengths and thicknesses, depending upon the volume of binder and mulch used.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

The mat is sprayed on from all directions to prevent “windowing” and to maintain close contact with the soil surface. BFM's totally cover the soil surface by building up a series of layers, preventing water from undermining the mat. With multiple layers applied, BFM's are extremely strong having the ability to withstand heavy rainfall and erosion control issues associated with steep batters.

Not all hydroseeders or contractors have ability and/or experience in quality BFM application. Hydroseeder pumps have to be specially modified or purpose built to operate with the high viscosity mixes and long fibrous mulches. Operator training is required to apply some BFM products.
